RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Do you know of anyone who might be interested in learning about the Catholic Church? The process by which adults and teens come into the Church has come to be known as “**THE RCIA**”, which is short for “The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults”.

The unbaptized. The primary focus of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is on those who are not already Christian and have not been catechized.

Baptized but uncatechized. Those who have been baptized either as Roman Catholics or as members of another Christian community, but did not receive further catechetical formation or instruction. These typically have also not celebrated Confirmation or Eucharist.

Those seeking full Catholic Communion. These are baptized, practicing Christians from other denominations seeking entry into the Catholic Church.

RCIA classes begin on **Monday, September 16, 2019**. Classes are from 7-9 PM in the Social Hall.
