BASILICA BOOK CLUB

There was a great discussion at the last Basilica Book Club Meeting. Thank you to Annelle Edward for providing and leading the discussion questions.

The new book was voted on: **Man's Search for Meaning** (165 pages). This is a book written by Viktor Frankl chronicling his experiences as a prisoner in Nazi Concentration Camps during World War II, and describing his psychotherapeutic method, which involved identifying a purpose in life to feel positive about, and then immersively imaging the outcome. According to Frankl, the way a prisoner imagined the future affected his longevity. The book intends to answer the question "How was everyday life in a concentration camp reflected in the mind of the average prisoner?" Part One constitutes Frankl's analysis of his experiences in the concentration camps, while Part Two introduces his ideas and his theory called logotherapy.

According to a survey conducted by the Book-of-the-Month Club and the Library of Congress, Man's Search for Meaning belongs to a list of "the ten most influential books in the United States. At the time of the author's death in 1997, the book had sold over 16 million copies and had been translated into 24 languages.
